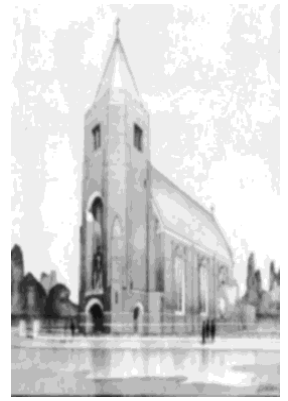

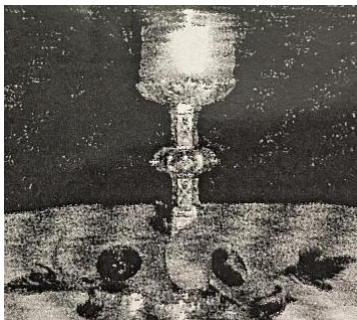

## FOOD BANK APPEAL

Please continue to bring in items for the Salvation Army Food Bank. They are desperate for tinned and dried food (but not pasta and cereals). Also welcome are tea, coffee, sugar, UHT long-life milk and meals in a tin e.g. meat plus anything for homeless people with no cooking facilities. They are not, however, allowed to accept alcoholic drinks. There are Boxes at the back of church.

### NEW MASS BOOKS

The Translation of the Readings for Mass are changing. As a result we have had to replace the books that are used on the Lectern and the Book of the Gospels.

There are four new Lectionary Books at a cost of £175.00 each and a Book of the Gospels at a cost of £395.00. Total Cost - £1,095.00.

Also:

The Books for the Congregation cost £5.00 each and we will need eventually to purchase 150 x 2 for Year A, plus the same for Year B and Year C. This is a big outlay for the parish so we would hope that when our church re-opens for Saturday and Sunday Masses, parishioners may wish to sponsor some of the books we have to buy.
